During the food intolerance test, multiple nutriment with values higher than 30 (the empirical limit of the method) were observed. These can be found on the left side in the darker column grouped wrt nutriment type. The high IgG (immunoglobulin G) level does not signify an allergy, rather it shows that the body produces immune proteins in the intestinal wall upon long-term consumption of specific foods. Higher titer-value foods are most likely to trigger complaints. However, it is possible that despite a higher IgG titer, patient may have no complaint. This has to be verified by the exemption test. The selected foods must be stopped even for months if needed, while watching out for complaints and change of state. Whereby complaints abate or cease after the given nutriment are withdrawn, the likely connection between the diet and the complaints becomes obvious. The foods that can be safely consumed can be found in the rightmost column. I hereby enclose a printed version of the test.
