#### Anamnesis:

The 14 year old girl has a genetic disorder of unknown origin, localized in the skin, connective tissue and joints. It began at the age of 3 months and has since then progressed. The little girl has been forced into a wheelchair, her joints are in contraction and her body is full of scar-covered wounds. Patient has ocular deviation and vision is greatly reduced.

Patient was examined in Hungary both at Heim Pal Hospital and Telki Hospital. Since parents reside abroad, patient was priorly examined in Germany, London and in the U.S.

All tests had the diagnosis of a genetic disorder of unknown origin in common.

Based on the medical tests in Germany (IgG antibody) the child was placed on a milk-, egg- and gluten-free diet, and when patient was not given meat, skin condition improved. In England, upon recommendation, patient started receiving milk and gluten, her skin has since deteriorated highly and ulcers appeared on her skin.

As a result parents attend nutritional counselling and roboration.

#### Proposal:

To compensate the loss of protein ( due to the epidermis deficient skin) we administer an extensively hydrolized nutriment and an amino acid preparative - a hypoallergenic pulp to enable roboration.
