Medical History:

Eczema-like skin symptoms and oral thrush after a 3-month vaccination. Worsening skin mutation at the age of 3.5 after administered vaccine. Development of milk and gluten sensitivity during this time, deterioration of skin condition upon consumption of the aforementioned. Effect mitigated by diet. Strong abdominal pains, mucous diarrhoea and continuous oral thrush due to antibiotics taken during this period.

Received test results: abdominal ultrasound, laboratory, stool (Candida)

Diagnosis: Candidiasis. Food Allergy. Eczema.

Opinion: It is likely that the vaccine launched a harmful adverse reaction and Candida, a fungal overgrowth, which further maintains the food allergies, inflammation of the digestive tract (Leaky GUTS syndrome) and dermatitis via a secondary infection. Strong antibiotics not recommended due to Candidiasis.

Milk-gluten and refined carbohydrates-free diet improves patient's condition - justifying the connection - these food allergens have also been shown by blood tests. The increased mono in the blood count points to a battle against parasites.

Due to the inflammation of the digestive tract shown by the ultrasound, there is a digestion and absorption disorder, which hinders body weight increase and maintains the state of deficiency. As a result of the poly-food allergy, the consumable number of foods is highly limited.

Recommendation:

- Strict avoidance of food allergens (see list), and refined carbohydrates, sugars, sweets, yeasty foods.
- Skin-friendly bathing gels (antibiotic-free)
- Intestinal flora supplement
- Nystatin pulv 3x0, 200g
- Herbal immune system enhancer
- Defaecation 3 times a day
